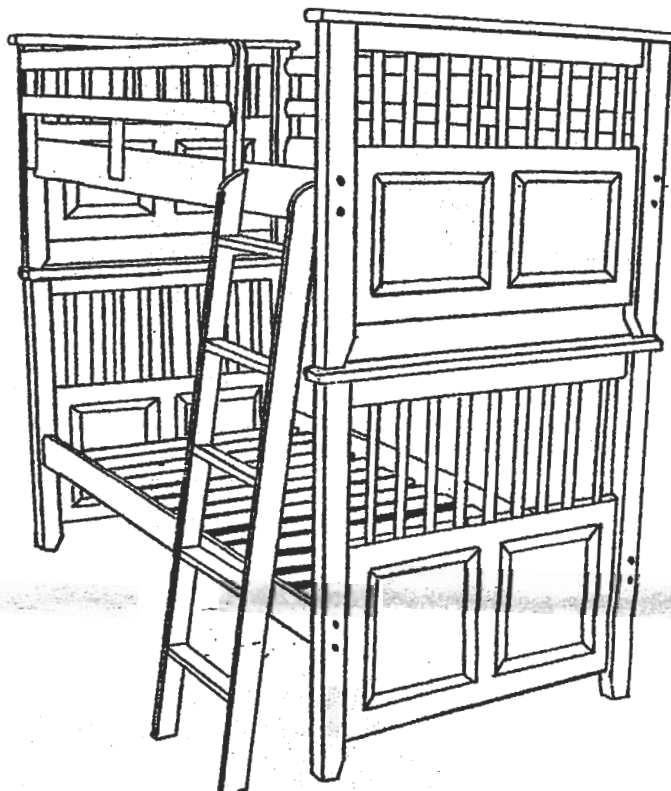


Pine Bunk Bed Assembly Instructions

Important: Read All Instructions Before Assembling. Please Save Instructions For Future Use

This Item Will Arrive in 5 Different Boxes:

- 1) Head & Footboards (For Top Bed)
- 2) Head & Footboards (For Bottom Bed)
- 3) 2 Side Rails & 14 Wood Slats for Bottom Bed
- 4) 2 Side Rails & 14 Wood Slats for Top Bed
- 5) A Set of 2 Guard Rails & Wooden Ladder

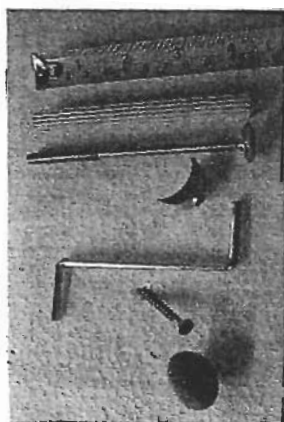


MAIN DIAGRAM

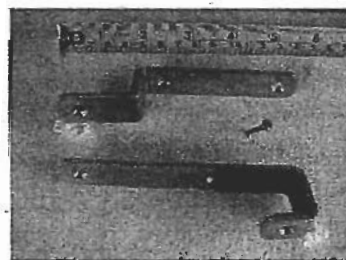

HARDWARE INCLUDES:



- 4 x wood dowels
- 16 x 4" bolts
- 16 x half-moon nut
- 1 Allen wrench
- 56 x 1 1/4" wood screws
- 4 x wood caps



- 6 x guard rail brackets
- 24 x 1/2" wood screws
- 2 x ladder hooks

RECOMMENDED TOOLS:

ELECTRIC SCREWDRIVER
(WITH PHILIPS HEAD BIT)



We recommend using two persons to assemble the bunk bed.

Step 1 Using the two headboards and two side rails, assemble the bottom bed. Connect the two side rails into one headboard. Use 8 bolts and 8 half-moon nuts. (See Diagrams 1, 2, 3 and 8.)

Step 2 Bring the other end of the two side rails up simultaneously, and connect it to the other headboard. (See Diagram 7.)

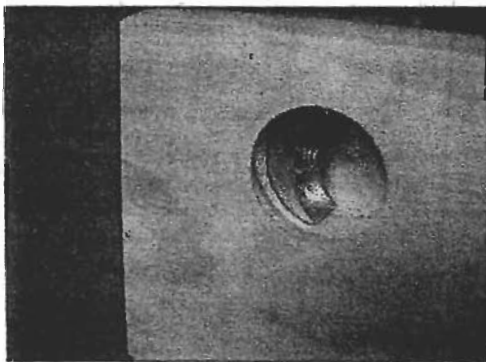

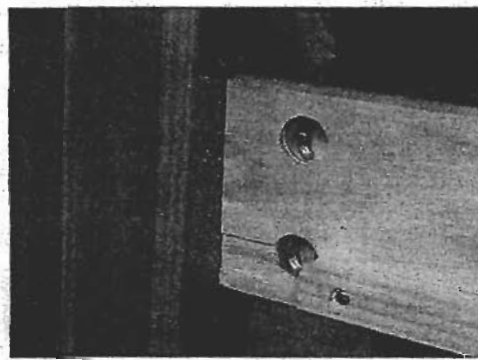

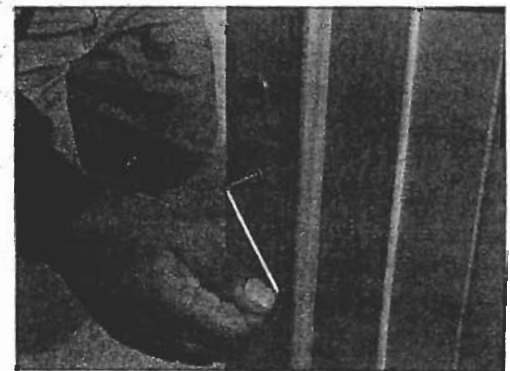

Step 3 Space the wood slats evenly in between the two side rails. Make sure that the space between the first wood slat and the headboard is less than 3". Attach the wood slats into the side rail lip using 28 1 1/4" wood screws. (See Diagrams 8 and 9.)

Note: Wood slats must be secured tightly in between the side rails.

Step 4 Assemble the top bed using the two footboards the same way you assembled the bottom bed (Steps 1-3).

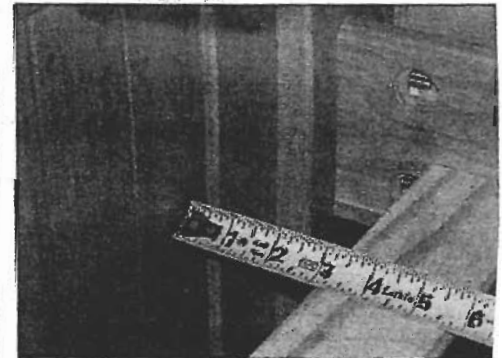

Step 5 Connect the guardrail brackets using 1/2" wood screws to both guardrails. For your convenience, locations to connect the brackets are pre-marked on each of the guardrail legs. (See Diagram 5)

Step 6 Connect the guardrails to the top bed rails. (See Diagram 4.) Please note: The long guardrail will be facing the wall. The short guardrail will be facing the center of the room and needs to be attached flush against one of the end panels (footboard) to allow appropriate space for the ladder. (See Diagram 4 and 10.)

Step 7 Insert 4 wood dowels to the pre-drilled holes on top of the headboards (bottom bed).

Step 8 Lift the top bed and place it on top of the bottom bed, making sure that approximately half of the wood dowels are being inserted into pre-drilled holes that are on the bottom legs of the top bed.

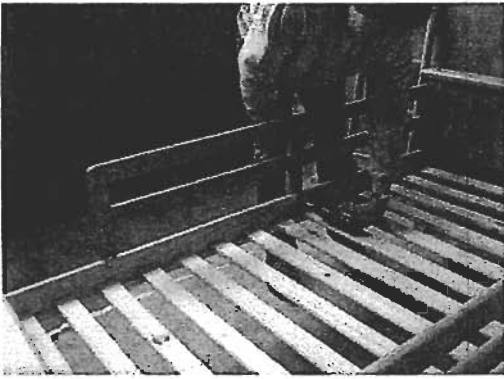

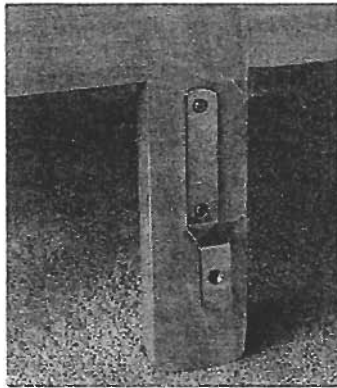

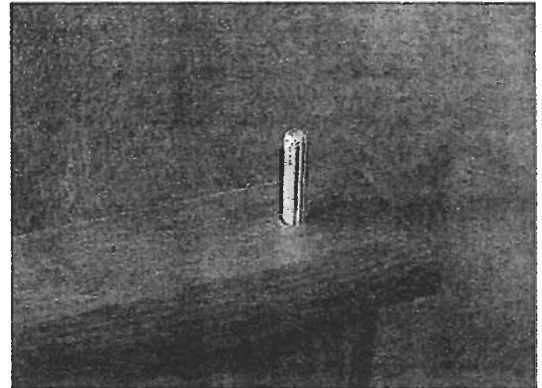

Step 9 Attach the ladder hooks to the ladder using two 1/2" wood screws on each bracket. (Locations for the screws on the ladder are pre-marked.) (See Diagram 11.)

Step 10 Connect the ladder to the top bed rail using two 1/2" wood screws. (See Diagram 10.)

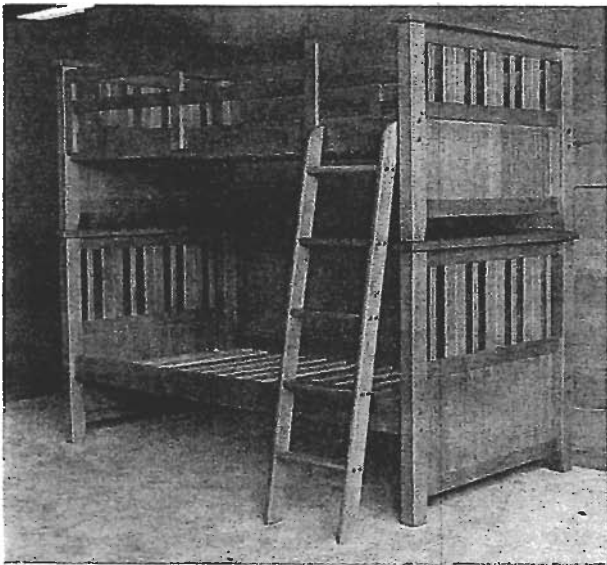

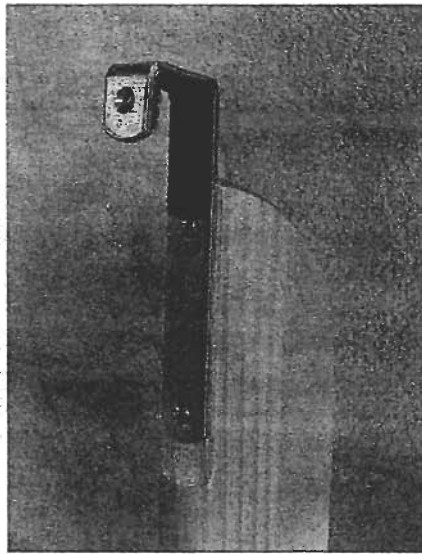

Safety Warnings

- 1.) Follow the information on the warning label attached to the upper bunk end structure. Do not remove this label.
- 2.) Always use the recommended size mattress or mattress support, or both, to help prevent the likelihood of entrapment or falls.
- 3.) Surface of mattress must be at least 5 in. below the upper edge of guardrails. Use only a mattress that is 74in. long and 37 in. wide, but not exceeding 7 in. in thickness.
- 4.) Do not allow children under 6 years of age to use the upper bunk.
- 5.) Periodically check and ensure that the guard rail, ladder, and other components are in their position, free from damage, and that all connectors are tight.
- 6.) Do not allow horseplay on or under the bed and prohibit jumping on the bed. Prohibit more than one person on the upper bunk.
- 7.) Always use the ladder for entering and leaving the upper bunk.
- 8.) Do not use substitute parts. Contact manufacturer or dealer for replacement parts.
- 9.) Use of a night light may provide added safety precaution for a child using the upper bunk.
10. Always use guardrails on both long side of the upper bunk.
- 11.) The use of water or sleep floatation mattress is prohibited.
- 12.) Keep these instructions for future reference.
- 13.) Always use the guardrails on both long sides of the upper bunk. If the bunk bed will be placed next to the wall, the guardrail that runs the full length of the bed should be placed against the wall to prevent entrapment between the bed and wall.
